



PCYC BOAT HAUL-OUT 2021

This notice provides key dates and detailed requirements to ensure a successful and timely haul-out of PCYC boats.

PCYC boats are handled in one of the following 3 categories:

- (1) **Dry-sailed** and other boats hauled and/or stored by members, themselves;
- (2) **Boats under 8,000 lbs** (3600 kgs) will be hauled by club equipment (mast up or down);
- (3) **Boats over 8,000 lbs** that must be hauled by a large commercial crane.
(The list of these boats has been determined and will be communicated.)

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS to be carried-out by boat owners:

- All boats to be hauled with masts up, must have **temporary backstay installed**.
- Rudder and tiller must remain in place, so boat can be properly towed, if required.
- Bow and stern lines (25foot) must be on deck to permit controlled crane lift.
- All trailers/cradles must be fully operational with tires inflated and no locks on the hitches, hull pads in place, threads greased. Boat name or owner name should be clearly identified.
- Dry-sailed boats remaining in the yard or sail shed must be clearly marked with owner's name.
- Dollies, masts, sails and accessories must also be marked or risk disposal.

Please note the following DEADLINES and REQUIREMENTS which may apply to your boat:

September 15th : All boats that wish to launch late spring 2022, must notify the office and book their launch date and will be placed on the north side of the yard.

September 27th : Haul-out date must be booked by this date; otherwise the Manager will schedule. Trailers / cradles for boats not stored at PCYC must be removed from the yard.

September 30th : Members NOT requiring boat storage on the Club premises DURING THE WINTER must advise the Club Manager.

October 8th : Members who haul their own boat must deliver it to the yard by this date. Mobility in the yard after this date will be difficult. Consult the office for any possible exceptions.

October 13th : All boats under 8,000 lbs will be scheduled and hauled by this date.

October 16th : Big crane haul-out (as per list).

Note: If you are ready and willing to be hauled prior to your scheduled date, please call the office.

ACCOUNTS: All accounts more than 30 days outstanding must be paid in full in order for your boat to be hauled and stored.

Your cooperation and efforts are appreciated and will help ensure a safe and successful haul-out.
