NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. The event is open to all qualified boats from PCYC. Boats entered must have a current SLVYRA handicap.

2.2. Qualification criteria for 2018:

2.2.1. Top three finisher from PCYC in any GNS series

2.2.2. Minimum of twelve GNS races, including races that were cancelled by the R/C.

2.2.3. Top three PCYC boats in the Mirage Cup.

2.3. Qualified boats must register by sailing past the stern of the race committee boat prior to the warning signal and hailing the boat's sail number and whether they are sailing White Sail or PHRF.

3. SCHEDULE

The scheduled time for the warning signal of the first race will be 1100h.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available online at the PCYC website and in print at PCYC.

5. COURSES

5.1. The course area start will be located approximately 1 nautical mile southwest of PCYC, near SLVYRA mark 32.

5.2. Two races are scheduled, one short race and one long race.

5.3. Courses will be provided in the sailing instructions. SLVYRA marks will be used.

6. SCORING

6.1. One completed race is required to constitute the Club Championship and Club Championship Regatta.

6.2. A boat that came to the starting area but did not start, did not finish, retired after finishing or was disqualified will be scored points equal to one more than the number of boats that came to the starting area. A boat that did not come to the starting area will be scored

points equal to two more than the number of boats that came to the starting area. This changes RRS A4.2.

7. PRIZES

7.1. Prizes will be awarded for the Club Championship, as follows: 1-3 entrants: 1st prize, 4 entrants: 1st and 2nd prizes, 5 entrants or more: 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes.

8. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate third-party liability insurance.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authorities will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after racing in the regatta.
